Responsibilities:

- Assist in the planning of menus in order to facilitate the organization of food supplies and meal preparation
- Assist the Kitchen Team Leader with inventory control, ordering, and shopping
- Working with the Kitchen team to coordinate and implement the daily meal service and catering requests
- Ensure the cleanliness of the kitchen and café areas at all times
- Follow safe food handling procedures during food preparation and meal service
- Assist in the planting, maintaining, harvesting of a small community garden
- Participate in continuous quality improvement processes and assist the ALC Team with research and development of best practices
- Promote and maintain a high standard of customer service that is client focused
- Assist in providing volunteer training regarding safe food handling practices and/or health and safety knowledge
- Collaborate with other summer students to plan and execute a special event for the Summer
